**ACT Site Information:** The event is given on an outdoor grass field surrounded by four foot high fence. No crating against the fence. There is minimal cover / seating, so bring your own chairs and plan to work out of your car. Event held rain or shine. There is no food service at the site; light snacks and water will be available free. Water for the dogs is available from a hydrant. Bring treats for your dogs.

**Site location: very convenient to NJ Routes 34 and 18 in Central Monmouth County.**

**Trial Site Rules:** 1) Dogs off leash only at the practice jump and in the ring. 2) You must pick up after your dog and deposit waste in trash cans provided. 3) 5 mph speed limit.

*Site is an active firehouse; certain parking places are reserved.*

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine PartnersSM applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
