Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be accepted. Late Entries after Sept. 13th will be charged the Day of Entry fee of \$30 per entry. Day of entries as space allows with secretary permission.

ABOUT RETURNED CHECKS: DRMarketing will not return checks for entries that are not accepted, or entries cancelled by the competitor before the closing date and before the check has been deposited. We shred all unused checks. All mail in entries must be accompanied with payment to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry. A Returned Check for insufficient funds will be charged an additional \$30 fee.

Arrive at least 1 hour prior to your approximate start time for inspection and check-in. We will be having a rolling inspection to accommodate Dogs that are also entered in other events. Dogs that are not checked in before the end of the end of the trial closing, we will assume you are absent, and you will lose your turn. No monies will be refunded for dogs not checked in ahead of time

Volunteers and Judges working the entire trial will run FIRST before all other competitors to ensure a smooth-running trial.

ROLL CALL

Members of the field committee may begin one-half hour prior to published test hours. All dogs may be measured by wicket to verify handicaps.

***Bitches in season and lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded.** Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.

Collar Rules: Dogs may run without a collar or wear any type of collar except choker collars, electronic training collars or head collar. Collars should be snug. Hanging tags pose a safety concern and will not be allowed. Dogs may run muzzled if desired. Clips or rubber bands may be used to keep long hair from falling across the dog's field of vision. No Open toe shoes or bare feet allowed anywhere on the course! NO prong collars are allowed anywhere in the park on AKC grounds as per the AKC!

Awards

Ribbons; CAT Qualifying course = Orange

Title Rosettes; title rosettes for CA, CAA. A special ribbon for CAX. If you believe you may title your CAX please make note on your entry form so we can be prepared for the amount needed

GENERAL Information

Gasoline and electric powered lure machines will be used. Back up equipment will be available.

- THERE WILL BE A \$5.00 FINE ASSESSED FOR ANY LOOSE DOG NOT TAKING PART IN THE COURSE IN PROGRESS or for anyone caught not picking up after their dog.
- NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the field chairperson, except the appointed field committee.
- Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary actions . and **entry fees will not be refunded**
- Control of dogs strictly enforced on leash or crated at all times except when running.
- PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN SHELTER. This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly
- **CAT events** are open to all dogs that are individually registered with the AKC, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation & signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Dogs must be at least one year of age on the day of the trial.
- Dogs may only run once per test. One dog per entry form per test.
- Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- **Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running**
- **All Dogs run at owners' sole risk**
- BCDC makes every attempt to facilitate that all entrants will be accommodated with regard to running the in the trials, but it is also the responsibility of each entrant to try to be ready when their dog is called to the line.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.
- **No entry fees will be refunded** if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather, conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the event-hosting club,
- Porta Potty will be available for competitors
- **Junior handler must be at least 9 yrs. of age to be on course as per the AKC junior handler requirement. No children besides the junior handler will be allowed on the course.**

Distance and Time

300 Yard Course. This distance is for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers and/or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs. A dog must complete this course in less than 1½ minutes.

600 Yard Course. This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300-yard course. A dog must complete this course in less than 2 minutes.

If there is a question which course a dog should run, the judge will decide. The dog must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption

WHAT MUST MY DOG DO TO PASS THE C.A.T.?

The Coursing Ability Test (C.A.T.) is a pass/fail test. To pass, the dog must chase the plastic lure, and complete the course 1 time, by himself, with enthusiasm and without interruption within the maximum amount of time. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog's performance

DOGS LESS THAN 12" TALL & "FLAT FACED" DOGS. Any entrant that is less than 12" tall at the withers and/or brachycephalic (for example a bulldog) will run a clearly marked 300-yard course that is basically rectangular in shape with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. A dog must complete the test in less than 1 ½ minutes.

DOGS MORE THAN 12" TALL. Any entrant that is taller than 12" at the withers and not brachycephalic shall run a clearly marked 600-yard course (or as close to 600 yards as possible) that is rectangular in shape with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. For a 600-yard course, a dog must complete the test in less than 2 minutes.

CAN MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR COURSING ABILITY?

Three titles will be awarded for dogs that pass the Coursing Ability Test the required number of times. These are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher-level title superseding a lower-level title.

Coursing Ability (CA) – Awarded to a dog that passes the Coursing Ability Test three times under at least two different judges.

Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA) - Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test ten times.

Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX) – Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test 25 times.

Trial Site Directions

From North: GSP (Garden State Pkwy) South, Go South on Rt. 9 towards Freehold. Take exit for Rt. 18 South (left exit). Follow Rt. 18 South to exit for Rt. 537 West (towards Freehold). Before second light on Rt. 537 West, follow sign bearing to the right jug handle to make a left on Kozloski Rd. Show site is approximately 0.5 miles on the right.

From Northeast: Rt. 537 West to Kozloski Road. Before Kozloski, follow sign bearing to the right jug handle to make a left on Kozloski Rd. Show site is approximately 0.5 miles on the right.

From East: Take Rt. 33 West to Kozloski. Take a left up the ramp to get onto Kozloski Blvd heading north. Follow to site on left approximately 0.6 miles to site. If exiting GSP at NJ-33 heading W towards Freehold you can: 1. Bear right onto Business 33 past the intersection with Fairfield Road and then follow direction above or 2. Take Highway 33 and exit northbound onto Halls Mill Rd., which changes name to Kozloski Rd at the Howell/Freehold border and then follow directions above. From West: Take Rt. 33 East to Halls Mill Rd Exit (This is past the Rt. 33, Rt. 537, and Rt. 9 exits). Take Halls Mill Rd. North (it turns into Kozloski) to site on left.



Be sure to bring plenty of shade and water for your dog!
