

IMPORTANT EVENT INFO PLEASE READ:

Due to the current Covid-19 pandemic, some additional rules and regulations will be in place for this event. As the state is changing rules every few weeks, these rules may change prior to this event. Please check the judging program for the most up to date safety precautions for this event.

Final event rules will be listed in the judging program. Expect the following at this event:

- Due to the pandemic, indoor crating will only be allowed in designated areas on the agility turf. You will only be allowed in this area to retrieve/return them to their crate. Dogs that are aggressive to passing dogs/people or that continuously bark or cry will not be permitted to crate anywhere in the agility area.
- Due to the pandemic, no spectators or unentered persons or dogs are allowed to enter the building. Signs will be posted throughout our site reminding all participants to wear a mask and socially distance in order to be in compliance with current COVID guidelines.
- MASKS MUST BE WORN: Inside the building covering nose and mouth at all times. This includes when warming your dog up, walking and in ring. There are no exceptions to Mask wearing. Volunteers are also required to wear a mask. Masks may be removed outside as long as social distance can be achieved. These requirements may change based on the NJ Governor's Guidelines at the time of any given event.
- Reminder to all competitors to read their final confirmations for updated COVID rules. We will be following the latest information and will continue to adapt their policies as needed to stay in compliance. Hospitality: Due to the Pandemic, no food is to be distributed inside for workers. During Covid, we will not allow persons to eat inside the building. Exceptions are those eating in private offices such as office staff, Trial Chair, Trial Secretary, and Judge.
- Attendees should come prepared with their own food, water and other personal needs. Competitors should plan to eat outside or in their cars.
- Please remind all participants to please stay home if they are not feeling well or have any symptoms whatsoever.

Jump Height is required for all obedience classes with jumps.

Classes with jumps will run in **ascending jump height order**,
beginning with the lowest jump in all trials. Exceptions to jump height running
order may be made for handlers with multiple entries.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or
handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials.
The club will refund entry fees less \$10.00 for bitches in season that are unable
to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated,
signed letter on official business letterhead from veterinarian stating the reason
that your dog cannot compete.

The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start
of the first class in the trial.

There will be no refund for injury or illness after entries close.

Directions from the North

Garden State Parkway to exit 100A towards Freehold. Merge onto 66W, turn right onto Shark River Road. Right turn into Shafto Road.

Directions from the South

Garden State Parkway North to exit 100C NJ-66 W towards Freehold. Merge onto 66W Right turn onto Shark River Road, Right turn onto Shafto Road. ***GPS may take you exit 105, but this will put you on the wrong side of the road. To avoid making a U-turn please use exit 100A or 100C***

From 295: Take Exit 60 to I-195E to NJ-138E. Take Exit 35B to merge onto NJ-34N toward Matawan. Follow to Shafto Road. Building on Right.

******TRIAL REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS******

- All judging will be indoors.
- Transfers will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16. and Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 15. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Due to judging limits, there is no guarantee that all requested transfers can be honored.
- A wait-list will be established in order to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing day.
- Obedience and Rally classes will run in jump height order from "Small to Tall" all three days.
- Your jump height must be included on the entry form for all classes that require a jump.
- **Crating:** No crating in the building, but limited crating will be permitted in designated area in adjacent agility area. The building will open Friday, Saturday and Sunday at 7:30 AM. Unentered dogs may be asked to leave. Please provide your own chairs and crates. No ex-pens.
- Free admission / Free parking. No food vendors will be at this event.
- **REFUND POLICY:** Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in obedience trials. The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee for bitches in season that are unable to compete for that reason. Refund requests must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. The Trial Secretary must be notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. E-mails, phone calls and non-letterhead notes will not be considered. There will be no refund for injury or illness after entries close.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. No dogs under 4 months of age on show grounds. No smoking in the building. Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner.
- The judge is not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. All dogs present must be held on a leash, or confined to a crate except when being judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the sole discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The host club, its members, agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
